



RONALD REAGAN PRESIDENTIAL MUSEUM AND DEAD SEA SCROLLS

When was the last time that you saw the Dead Sea Scrolls? Well, you have a chance to see them again. On Wednesday, May 21, we will be taking a docent-led tour of the Reagan Library and enjoy a catered lunch under the wing of Air Force One. This will be followed by free time to tour the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibit and other displays. Discovered in caves near the West Bank, and written in Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek, the Dead Sea Scrolls are a collection of manuscripts dating back as far as the 3rd century BC. They are kept in a secure and climate-controlled environment and are only on display every five years.
